PARADE RULES

1. An authorized representative of each parading unit must check-in at Pembroke High School located at Learning lane in Pembroke, MA.. Registration opens at 10:00am and closes at 12:00pm. Step-off will be at 1pm. Look for the committee representative in charge of sign-in located in a golf cart on the High School grounds at Learning Ln..
2. All parade vehicles must be at Pembroke High School by 12:00 pm. For safety reasons no vehicles will be allowed on Learning Lane after 12:30pm with the exception of those lined up in divisions for the parade.
3. No buses or cars are allowed to park on Learning Lane.
4. All transportation units (buses, vans, etc.) will discharge passengers at Pembroke High School and proceed to the designated parking area at the end of the parade route. (behind the community center in Pembroke center or other designated area).
5. Music is allowed and encouraged from floats.
6. The throwing of candy or any objects from the floats is not allowed. Candy, etc. may be passed out (handed) by persons walking along side of the float.
7. Units with animals in their group must provide their own sanitary engineers to clean up wherever the animals may have been present.
8. All units must stay in the line of march past the reviewing stand and the TV camera platforms, continuing on Center Street until shown where to disperse at or before the Town Hall parking lot. Signage will be in place on the day of the parade marking these locations.
9. Drilling will be permitted only in a forward motion in the line of march during the parade.
10. The parade committee reserves the right to withdraw any unit that does not conform to the standard of reasonable public taste and safety
11. All persons riding on or in a float must take proper safety precautions.
12. All units will be notified of their division location in the line of march one week prior to the parade. The division location may be adjusted up to step off.
13. Politicians are invited to participate however no politicking will be allowed.
