Payroll and Warrants signed. Whitman made motion to accept April 3, 2017 minutes and seconded by Federico

Request from a resident for relief from a high water bill which had a leak in a meter pit. Whitman made motion to lower the bill to the lowest tier and Federico seconded.

Letter from a resident at 201 Mattakeesett Street. Glauben has been out to the location with Mass DOT rep already. Request was also sent to Mass DOT. Both Whitman and Federico agreed to leave the decision up to Mass DOT.

Route 14 Corridor update: Curve Street to Route 53 – Removal of trenches. Replace curb stops and abandon the 8" main. Landers plan to have all drainage, sidewalk and paving done from the Hanson town line to Stop and Shop.

Route 36 Corridor update – When contract is signed will have DCI meet with Conservation prior to the 100% design final phase. Looks like the project is predicted for 2022.

Perpetual rate increase of 2% on water so that water projects can get started. Will slate it for discussion at a future meeting.

Work Order discussion on a wash-out on West Elm Street that has not been taken care of. Glauben stated that man power has been an issue but is scheduled for tomorrow, Wednesday or Thursday at the latest.

A request to waive internment fee for Nicholas Viviano as parents have not been working during the son's illness. Whitman made motion to waive the internment fee and Federico seconded.

Whitman made motion to adjourn this meeting at 7:20 and to move to the joint selectman's meeting for presentation of the DPW Space and Needs Study Results with no future business to be conducted.
