Mr. Madden stated that there is root erosion on the large old oak tree by the bridge at Herring Run Park. It needs to be tested and treated, probably 200-250 years old. Mr. Clarke suggested he get quotes to have this done and present findings. The money could come from the forestry account. Mr. Fellini noted that the parking lot needs to be leveled at the park as well. Many other upgrades are needed as well.

Mr. Madden stated he saw a “widow maker” by Glenwood that needs to be addressed. Mr. Clarke will inspect.
