
New proposed member also present at meeting. He will fill out an application. Brendan Mosher 16 Alvern Rd.

2. Discussion about the Spring Migration and the count of Herring. Waiting for the final count from DMF. Counter was 344,000 when DMF pulled because of fish passage both ways.
3. Discussion about Brockton Water completion of new screens at diversion site. New screens installed. Mark will forward a letter to Brockton Water thanking them.
4. Discussion about next year having a Fish Fry with DMF and others. Mark wants someone to lead the planning and bring details to the next meeting.
5. Discussion about the use of Drones for checking areas of concern. Look for possible article in Special Town Meeting for new drone for checking areas of concern. Bill B will ask Ed Thorn if the Town has the funds.
