 - c. Taylors' message, Donna would like to bring that back to PCMS
 - d. PTO going to have Hope Beyond Hope, sober house in Weymouth to speak to high school 11th and 12th grade, right before feb vaca, 2020 grad will speak who went through the program, and we may have them come back for 9th and 10th grade
 - e. Mental Health clinician—Police applying for a grant for one to share with Hanover. Confident they can get grant. Logistics being discussed
 - f. Abington Coalition, reached out to Mike for help starting theirs
 - g. John Cross is on board of The Family Restored, is a recovery house, asking us for how we could work together. He will talk to his board about collaboration
 - h. Interface alternative-Jess thought Erin would share with us, it is a similar program and we can help fund it
 - i. Town wellness fair-more people than expected, at library, We got a lot of positive feedback, people were able to see the photovoice project while there
