

Town of Pembroke Recycling and Sustainability Committee Thursday, August 24, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. Pembroke Public Library Trustees Meeting Room

Minutes:

Members in attendance: Meghan Watts (chair), Kairyn Rainer (clerk), Stephen Curley, Katherine Kopper. Charles Marshall (candidate for committee membership) also in attendance.

Ms. Watts called the meeting to order at approximately 7:00pm. Ms. Watts proceeded to agenda item 1: approval of minutes from June 2023 meeting. Ms. Rainer reported that she was unable to complete minutes from June and this item will be moved to next meeting's agenda along with approval of April 2023 meeting minutes.

Committee Membership: Ms. Watts asked Mr. Marshall to leave the room for a vote on his application, which he did. Ms. Watts asked if everyone had reviewed the application for Charles Marshall, which the members responded they had. We reviewed it together and Ms. Watts asked for a motion to approve the application of Mr. Marshall for review by the town Select Board, which was made, seconded, and unanimously carried. Mr. Marshall was asked to rejoin the meeting and informed of this motion. Ms. Watts explained that he would now need to be approved by the Select Board at their next meeting in order to become a member.

Info at Pembroke Celebrates: The committee discussed that the information table would be focused on composting and would include a compost sorting game for children using fake foods and baskets for sorting, fliers about composting, and committee members engaging residents in discussion and answering questions. Ms. Watts and Ms. Kopper will attend the event and Ms. Kopper will create visual aids about composting. Ms. Rainer will bring her recycling toter as she did last year. Ms. Watts asked for a motion to adjourn, which was moved, seconded, and unanimously carried. Ms. Watts adjourned the meeting at approximately 8:00pm.
