

**PEMBROKE CONSERVATION COMMISSION

The Conservation Commission will be in attendance of the MEPA Consultation Session for the Route 14 Reconstruction Project. An Environmental Notification Form (ENF) has been submitted to the Massachusetts Environmental Policy Act (MEPA) office for this project. The project includes the reconstruction of Route 14 from the Hanson Town Line to Route 53 (Washington Street) in Pembroke. Specific project elements include: roadway widening to provide a uniform 30-foot cross section; construction of 5.5 foot sidewalks; reconstruction of 5 culverts; geometric improvements at 7 intersections; stormwater and drainage improvements; and installation of new signs and pavement markings. The project will temporarily or permanently impact various wetland resources areas including BVW, Land Under Water, Bank, Riverfront and Bordering Land Subject to Flooding. Portions of the project site contain Priority or Estimated Habitat identified by the Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program (NHESP). The project will require a Section 401 Water Quality Certificate from MassDEP and an Order of Conditions from the Pembroke Conservation Commission.
