- 4. VARIANCE FROM SECTION 310 CMR 15.211 OF THE STATE SANITARY CODE WHICH REQUIRES A MINIMUM 200' SETBACK FROM A TRIBUTARY TO A SURFACE WATER SUPPLY TO A SEPTIC TANK OR PUMP CHAMBER. VARIANCE ALLOWING A REDUCTION FROM 200' TO A MINIMUM OF 75' IS REQUESTED.
