

**MINUTES OF THE SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
JANUARY 7, 2020**

At 7:30 pm Mr. Boyle opened the meeting. Eagle Scout Jacob Twigg was present and congratulations were offered to Mr. Twigg on this magnificent achievement.

**VOTE REGARDING HOUSEKEEPING MATTER: APPLICATION FROM MARYLOU'S NEWS, INC. D/B/A MARYLOU'S COFFEE FOR COMMON VICTUALER'S LICENSE TO BE EXERCISED AT 759A WASHINGTON STREET**

Ms. MaryLou Sandry operates a coffee shop serving prepared food to the public at 759A Washington Street in Pembroke and is need of a Common Victualer's License under MGL c140 s2, otherwise there is a violation of MGL c.140 §20. On Monday, January 6th the Board of Health held a hearing on a violation of tobacco sales without a local permit, the outcome which determined this violation occurred as a result of an office/housekeeping error. Fines, back permitting and permitting costs were paid in full and this application is approved to be licensed by the Selectmen. Ms. Rushing moved to grant MaryLou Sandry of MaryLou's News, Inc. d/b/a MaryLou's Coffee a Common Victualer's License in accordance with the provisions of MGL c140 s2 to be exercised at 759A Washington Street in Pembroke. Mr. Trabucco seconded the motion. The vote was unanimously in favor.

**VOTE REGARDING APPLICATION OF PEMBROKE HISTORICAL SOCIETY FOR SPECIAL LIQUOR LICENSE (MGL C.138 §14, "ONE DAY") ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2020 FROM 6:30 PM - 9:00 PM AT 116 CENTER STREET**

Mr. Trabucco moved to approve the request of the Pembroke Historical Society for a One Day Liquor License under MGL c.138 §14 to serve beer and wine from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm on February 8, 2020 at 116 Center Street; Mr. Brown seconded the motion. The vote was unanimously in favor.

**VOTE TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF DECEMBER 30, 2019**

Mr. Brown moved to approve the minutes of December 30, 2019 as written; Mr. Trabucco seconded the motion. The vote was 3/0/1 with Ms. Rushing abstaining.

**TOWN MANAGER'S REPORT**

Old Colony Planning Council has posted updates from MassDOT regarding the following projects: In Duxbury/Kingston at the north and south bound ramps at exit 10 on route 3, new traffic signal design is at 25% completion; in Pembroke the Route 36 Project from the center to the intersection at Route 27 is at 100% design, scheduled for 2022 with one remaining question concerning sidewalks at Liberty Drive, and multi-town Route 53 work to widen and pave the roadway through Pembroke scheduled bid opening in March with an anticipated project start of summer 2020.

At 7:40 pm, Mr. Boyle read the upcoming issues. Mr. Trabucco moved to enter executive session under M.G.L. c.30A, Sec. 21(6) to consider the purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property if the chair declares that an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the negotiating position of the public body; 660 Washington Street; Mr. Boyle declared it to be so and stated that the Board will return to open session. Mr. Brown seconded the motion. By roll call vote: Brown – yes, Rushing – yes, Trabucco – yes, Boyle – yes. At 8:15, Ms. Rushing moved to adjourn; Mr. Brown seconded the motion. The vote was unanimously in favor.
