Bills were circulated for committee approval.

Matt Kreckie, Kaleigh Ryan and Brendan Duane of the Thespian society asked for approval from the school committee to wear colored cords at graduation and added that the Thespian troop will pay for them. Continued FY17 Budget Conversation

Alternative Reductions

Mr. Bosworth proposed the MASC fee of \$5k as a reduction. Mrs. Scroggins said that the policy subcommittee uses the MASC service so it should not be canceled. Mr. Bosworth asked the latest a teacher could be hired to be effective for next year and Mrs. Obey said by the end of this school year. Mr. Chilcott said he understands the need for an additional teacher but the reductions are not palatable to him. He suggested planning the addition into the following year's budget. Mr. Tropeano referred to the athletics numbers and said football participation is down, boys' basketball is up, wrestling is down but the drop in the girl's lacrosse surprised him. Mr. Chilcott said there are a lot of kids in multiple sports. Mr. Tropeano said programmatic shifts were made to achieve this year's budget. Mrs. Scroggins questioned why the committee is having this conversation about adding a teacher now and Mr. Tropeano said the committee had asked it be looked at because this addition fell just below the line priority wise. Mrs. Wandell said nothing has changed, the committee just wanted to take one last look at what it would take to add the teacher.

Mr. Bosworth said he would like to request this level of detail sooner and Mrs. Obey said this level of detail was given with the MOE budget. Mr. Tropeano confirmed that the budget conversations will be held earlier next budget season. Mr. Chilcott said it is about priorities and the committee is doing it correctly for the district. Mr. Bosworth said he agrees that he doesn't see anything he would want to cut and added that the sustainability of a position has to be considered.

Athletics – IV Golf

Mrs. Obey said only 10 students can play with one adult at the course. Mr. Tropeano asked what the cost is for JV golf and Mrs. Obey said about \$4k using this year's price. The price includes the coach, supplies and transportation. Mr. Tropeano said there are some questions around whether the group and carry 20 students and are they accommodating girls and Mrs. Obey said she will look into it. Mr. Tropeano said the committee should state that JV Golf is part of the athletics program.
