UNIT PRICES: Should the quantities of work performed under unit prices be increased or decreased from those on which the bid is based, by approval of the Architect, the undersigned agrees that the Unit Prices set forth below and in the Specifications will be the basis of payment to the Contractor or credit to the Awarding Authority for such increase, or decrease in the Work. The undersigned agrees that the Unit Prices given represent the exact amount per unit to be paid to the Contractor (in the case of additions or increases) or to be refunded to the Awarding Authority (in the case of decreases), and that no additional adjustment will be requested or allowed for general conditions, overhead, profit, insurance, worker's compensation insurance, or other direct or indirect expenses of Contractor or subcontractors. The unit prices provided will be used for an ADD to the Work and cover the description outlined below for each scope of Work. Where base contract amounts are indicated, Work not utilized under this Section will be taken as a DEDUCT and will be taken at fifteen (15%) less than the ADD price to account for overhead and profit. The Awarding Authority shall have the right to reject any or all proposed Unit Prices at any time prior to signing the Agreement, in which case the cost of extra work shall be as determined by one of the other methods set forth in Article 7 of the General Conditions.
